




CANCER JAGRUK RAJOKRI-EK PRAYAAS

ACTIVITY REPORT FOR JULY 2017

The need based survey report at Rajokri village identified 'Pahari' area as the most vulnerable zone. We started our awareness drive from 10th July 2017, door to door campaign was carried out and people were made aware of the planned awareness meeting in future. Our first awareness meeting was held on 14th at Barat Ghar, Rajokri. Our target age groups were in the age group between 18 to 55 years basically married women and men in the age group of 18- 65 years.


People came in batches, on spot registrations were done, which included filling in all personal details and also our questionnaires regarding their health status and general life style.













This meeting also involved a very open and encouraging discussion on general women health and associated problems. A talk on cervical cancer, oral cancer was delivered and symptoms associated with these cancers were discussed. Ways to identify and prevent were also discussed using informative charts.

Similar meeting was again held on 18th and 19th July, same earlier exercise was repeated with other batches.

In total around 85 people were addressed, although the number of male attendees was not encouraging.





Total pap smears taken in July is = 41

Total gynecological consultations in July is = 42

Total breast cancer examinations in July is = 85

Total Head &Neck consultations in July is = 70

The Pap test reports for both the camps have been received . Out of all the 41 smears, one female has to undergo further investigations.

Rest of the cases, have been found to have generalized cervical inflammation due to generalized infections . They have been prescribed medications.

REPORT DISTRIBUTION AND COUNSELLING

All the females whose pap test reports have been received and reviewed were called for a counseling session on 10^{th} August .

One lady by the name of Meera (code RAJ 116) Age - 47 years was found to have poorly differentiated carcinoma. She has been advised to undergo urgent cervical biopsy. The patient and her family was talked to and made to understand the situation. The family has a BPL card and they have to get the biopsy done on 14 August at Fortis hospital ,Vasant Kunj.

Other patients were advised

Azithral 500 mg one daily for 5 days. Candid-V vaginal pressaries or Clingen vaginal pressaries followed by a follow up

The females were advised to undertake good personal hygiene and made aware about basic cleanliness.
